# STANDING UP FOR BRITISH JEWS

## WE:

---

Lobby senior representatives of government to ensure that it remains supportive of Israel's right to defend itself.

---

Put the case for Israel and against anti-semitism, by speaking out across the media and challenging bias.

---

Press retailers when protestors call for the removal of Israeli or kosher products, to keep products on shelves.

---

Challenge councils that fly Palestinian flags.

---

Challenge political parties that refuse to discipline members who support violence or play up to antisemitism.

---

Work with other faith communities, so that both Christian and Muslim leaders condemn antisemitism

---

Work with other communal organisations and grassroots activists to reverse the Tricycle Theatre's effective ban on the Jewish Film Festival.

---

Fund Israel advocacy work around the country and help train and support grassroots activists.

---

Attend and help promote rallies and pro-Israel demonstrations across Britain.

The role of the Board of Deputies is to represent the interests and concerns of British Jews to government, media, policy makers and others. We work best when we work together.

## YOU:

---

*Write to your local MP to express your support for Israel.*

---

*Challenge the media every time you hear or read a biased report.*

---

*Support boycotts, such as Kedem in Manchester so this Israeli company is not disadvantaged by protests.*

---

*Complain directly to your local councillor and tell them not to import conflict.*

---

*Tell parties what you think of them if they don't take action*

---

*Reach out to your local church or mosque to get to know them and help them understand the Jewish community.*

---

*Challenge any cultural organisation that goes down a similar line.*

---

*Join or set up a local Israel advocacy group.*

---

*Support a range of initiatives and events in defence of Israel in the run up to next year's general election.*
